OPTIONAL: Student Credit on Account - Max \$100.00 – per student account

Parents may find it more convenient to deposit a sum (eg Maximum \$100 per student) into their students account and request the school allocate payments from that account as required. Costs are indicated on Term Charges notices sent out each school term. The balance of your child's account is available to you at any time in person or email request to the Manager Corporate Services. All remaining funds will be carried forward to the following year.

CONTRIBUTIONS

The total amount of contributions parents / caregivers of children in K-6 are \$60 per year - School Educational Act Regulations 2000.

The **Voluntary Contributions** received are used to further enhance educational activities for the school and students.

The school strongly urge all parents to pay the Voluntary Contribution amount when completing the Personal Items Lists. Campion Education will return the money to the school with a complete list of payment details.

P&C LEVY

The Voluntary **P&C Levy** has been set at \$55 per family.

The P&C strongly urge **all** parents to pay the P&C Levy amount when completing the Personal Items Lists Parents can also pay via cash or EFT at the front office.

Payment of this approved voluntary levy may be made via the Personal Items lists, in a total payment to Campion.

If you have not included the contribution with the Personal items list, the P&C would appreciate your payment at the beginning of the 2023 school year.
