- 2. Operational Improvements.

## **Embedding Sustainability into the Curriculum:**

- 1. All Classes: 3 CCPs embedded into all Learning Areas.
- 2. Carbon Reduction Initiative: 200 Tonne Plan (2024-26 Business Plan). Embed understandings & actions into class programs. Focus on energy and water audits, and 'outdoor classroom' bushland project.
- 3. 2024 focus animal: worms (using new Waste Sorted lesson plans); 2025 focus endangered animals.
- **4. Eco Footprint**: All teachers contribute 2 or more actions for their year level focus re Biodiversity (Yr 2), Waterwise (Yr 3), Your Move (Yr 4), Waste Sorted (Yr 5) & EnergySmart (Yr 6). U.N. International Year of Camelids; River Rangers; Roots & Shoots; Sustainability Leaders & other student leadership opportunities.
- 5. Social Handprint: All teachers contribute 2 or more actions for their year level focus re Aboriginal & TSI Cross Curriculum Priority (CCP) & Asian CCP. Participation in NRW, NAIDOC and Harmony Day.
- **6. Whole Systems Thinking**: Explicit links with footprint/handprint (SSWA), CCPs & STEM. Link to UN Sustainable Development Goals.
- 7. Staff Support: Embedding CCP explicitly into school wide plans & programs (esp. STEM); school networks; resource provision; partnerships; PLs; incursions & excursions; Music support; address Library use issues.
- 8. Established Initiatives: Enhance existing community networks/partnerships: Friends of Coolbinia Bushland; SDB; MLSHS; Acacia Care; SS WA; AAEEWA; SERCUL; Solar Buddy; City of Stirling Living Green bushland project; One World Centre; UNAA Global Citizenship Schools; Sustainable Futures; Curtin Uni (BASF Labs); Murdoch Uni (Outreach); UWA (STEM); DoT; DBCA; DWER; STEM Professionals in Schools.

## **Operational Improvements:**
