Year Groups: Years 5 & 6

<u>Arrival Time:</u> Students are to arrive at Coolbinia PS by 8am and wait in the Undercover Area ready to have their name ticked off by their sport specific teacher.

Travel:

- **Departure:** Buses will leave Coolbinia PS at 8:35am and arrive at the venues at 9am.
- Return: Buses will Leave the Sporting venues at 2:30 and arrive back at Coolbinia PS at 2:55pm.

<u>Teams:</u> Throughout Term 2 Mr. Porcaro, sports designated teachers' and assistant coaches have carefully selected suitable teams for the sports the students have chosen to play. Please ask your children what team they are playing in. The team lists will be put up on the Sport Noticeboard in the Undercover Area.

Equipment required on the day: (School bag containing the following)

- We suggest the students wear a warm jacket and trackpants on the day which they can easily take on and off (please make sure their name is on each item of clothing).
- Spare pair of socks and Coolbinia uniform to change into if wet at the end of the day.
- Wet weather gear. Rain jacket. We suggest not to bring umbrellas as they can be dangerous and large
 between matches we will endeavour to stay undercover/out of the rain.
- Lunchbox with Recess, Lunch, and some snacks to nibble on before/during/after games.
- Coolbinia PS will provide bibs/playing guernsey's for all teams.

Sport Specific Equipment:

• **AFL:** AFL boots with studs (not screw in studs) – these are not a requirement (normal sneakers are okay), a mouthguard (no mouthguard = no play), Coolbinia PS shorts and/or trackpants. Coolbinia PS uniform shirt. NO jewelry, bracelets, necklaces, watches etc. to be worn as they may be lost or be broken. Fingernails must be cut.
